¹ Per approval from the Board of Trustees on June 26, 2015, all Other Mandatory Fees (Transportation Access, Student Facilities Use, and Technology) assessed to College of Medicine students will now be charged at a 36 credit hour block rate, effective Fall 2015. Students in different cohorts are enrolled for the credit hours/semesters appropriate to their year in the program. All pay the Other Mandatory Block Fee annually, regardless of their actual credit hour enrollment.

² Students in different cohorts are enrolled for the credit hours/semesters appropriate to their year in the program. All pay the tuition block fee annually, regardless of their actual credit hour/semester enrollment. (The payment is divided across semesters for the academic year.)

³ Students in different cohorts are enrolled for the credit hours/semesters appropriate to their year in the program. All pay the Local Block Fee annually, regardless of their actual credit hour enrollment. This block fee is based on 36 hours, and includes the following fees: Athletic, Activity and Service, and Health.

College of Medicine Notes:

The academic year for the College of Medicine consists of Summer, Fall, and Spring semesters.

The Student Facilities Use Fee is not assessed to 3rd and 4th year College of Medicine students, as their studies are conducted off-campus.

A College of Medicine student taking six or more semester hours will pay the full rate as provided herein for tuition and fees. Any student approved to attend fewer than six semester hours will pay the tuition and fees at the Graduate Student Rate for the actual number of semester hours.
